

Underlay



We offer underlays for rugs and runners to prevent slipping, allow extra comfort and extend the rug's life. We recommend underlays for all wool rugs. Underlays are used beneath your rug on smooth or hard floors (timber, parquet, laminate, tile, stone, marble, cork, and PVC floor coverings) and on heated floors. It can be used on carpets to prevent rugs from creeping.

Newly sealed floors must be completely dry and cured before laying any rug or rug pad. Measuring 3 mm (1/8") in thickness, it provides additional walking comfort while satisfying the highest demands.

The underlay will be 5 cm (2") smaller than your rug on each side. Custom size available. Custom sizing includes circular shapes.

Fibre & construction

Fibre: **Needlefelt, with light adhesive finish on both sides**

Height: **3 mm (1/8")**

Underlay installation guide

1. Make sure the floor is vacuumed, clean and dry
2. Mark the position of the rug
3. Lay the underlay 50 mm inside the marks
4. Place the rug on top of the underlay
5. For oversized rugs, the underlay will be comprised of multiple pieces
6. Underlay can be trimmed using scissors if required
